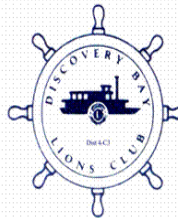

Discovery Bay Lions General Meeting Minutes  
July 1, 2008

Meeting called to order at 6:30pm by Lion President Dave Ciruli.

First guest introduced was Matt Caravello a 13 year old fishing tournament champion from Discovery Bay. He needs financial help to get into a world class fishing tournament in South Carolina. He has a high seeding in his age group and should make a good showing. He is sponsored by Lion Phil Paulson.

The second guest was our featured speaker Lion Virgil Koehne, General Manager of Discovery Bay Community Service District. Lion Virgil discussed waste water dangers in Discovery Bay and noted he is checking into the solar wind energy possibilities. Lion Virgil noted that FEMA is evaluating the levees. This may change the flood zone status, which could affect houses here in Discovery Bay. Water meters will be installed Discovery Bay West by January 2010. Penalties will be imposed for excessive water usage. The proposed business park by the post office, consisting 45 acres and 90,000 square feet of building space has been stopped indefinitely because of the economy. There is no progress with the community center for Discovery Bay.

Lion Robin Olson reported that the Poker Run will be held on August 8,9. The Golf Tournament will be held on Monday, August 11<sup>th</sup>.
